This message is being sent from the Richwood Emergency Operations and Mayor Mark Guthrie's office.

As of 8 am today, Richwood is seeing water in various area of the city. City crews are out placing barricades and High Water signs out along Four Oaks, Briar Creek, and Wisteria. We are also seeing water over the street on Brazos Crossing at 2004. The water is coming up fast. We are asking everyone not to drive around the barricades. If your vehicle is parked in the street, you need to consider moving the vehicle to higher ground. High profile vehicles are still good. We are still not anticipating water in homes within the city limits of Richwood, however we will see more water and more street closures throughout the day. In the Tamarind Woods area, we are seeing water encroaching up on the houses. We continue to ask everyone to keep a close watch.

We continue to receive reports of misinformation being placed on social media. The only official information regarding issues in Richwood will be put out by the City of Richwood on city letter head. If you want to verify any information out on social media, please contact the City at 979-265-2082.
