The latest update as of 10 am this morning.

The City of Richwood is seeing the water slowly recede. We have begun opening up roads along N and S Yaupon, and Magnolia. However, the area of Audubon Woods I and Glenwood Bayou will remain closed to vehicle traffic. We were in these areas this morning and there are areas with several feet of water covering the roadways and impassable by vehicle. We are still requiring proof of residency to enter these areas.

If you need assistance with getting out of the flooded area for medical reasons, please contact City Hall at 979-265-2082 and we will coordinate a time to pick you up. We are still utilizing Polk Elementary, the old swimming pool parking lot, and First Baptist Richwood as a staging area for lower profile vehicles.

We have seen several children playing in the water, please keep them away from the drainage areas.

We will be monitoring the water levels as well as the water still coming towards Richwood throughout the day and will make the decision as to when we can allow vehicle traffic as soon as conditions change.
