The latest update as of 5 pm.

The City of Richwood is continuing to see the water slowly recede. We have opened the roads around Briar Creek, Quail Run, and Four Oaks. However, the area of Audubon Woods I will remain closed to vehicle traffic. We assessed Audubon Woods and the water is still too deep in areas for vehicle traffic. We will also be assessing the Audubon Woods area to ensure hazards are removed once the water is low enough for potential vehicle traffic prior to opening the road. We are still requiring proof of residency to enter the Audubon Woods area.

If you need assistance with getting out of the flooded area for medical reasons, please contact City Hall at 979-265-2082 and we will coordinate a time to pick you up. We are still utilizing Polk Elementary, the old swimming pool parking lot, and First Baptist Richwood as a staging area for lower profile vehicles.

We have seen several children playing in the water, please keep them away from the drainage areas.

We will assess the water level again in the morning and will update everyone on any changes. If you have any questions, please let us know. We want to thank each one of you for your patience as we go through this.
