This message is being sent from the Richwood Emergency Operations and Mayor Mark Guthrie's Office.

The latest update as of 10 am this morning.

We were out assessing the water this morning in the Audubon Woods I subdivision. The water has receded to a level where we can begin opening the streets to through traffic. We still have water in some areas where the depth is deep and we will keep those streets closed. The areas of concern will be Robin Trail, Dove Trail, Audubon Woods Dr @ Audubon Woods Ct. We will keep barricades and high water signs up in the areas of concern and re-assess these areas throughout this morning. Public Works will ensure that all hazards are removed from the streets prior to us allowing traffic. This will be done first thing this morning. We will continue to watch the water being released from the northern areas of the state and will advise you if conditions change and warrant us going back into disaster mode.

City officials will be meeting to discuss removing barricades (where we can) as well as high water signs. We will also discuss a time frame for street clean up, debris removal, etc. and this information will be relayed to our residents.

We will be lifting the curfew as of today. Please use caution and be courteous to the residents who live in the area where water still stands as you travel those streets.

We would like to thank each one of you for all of your support and assistance with this event. I believe it was a team effort and OUR team came through for OUR city!
